1	Refer Section VI – TOR 6.9 :- No of Dedicated Vehicles required 4.5mt is 1 no. But in page no 52, Financial proposal asked for 2.5MT.	This is oversight and prospective bidders are requested to bid for 4.5MT in Financial Proposal, instead of 2.5MT. Refer to revised Appendix G in this corrigendum
2	Refer Section VI – TOR 6.10.02 :- Distance of FTL will be based on Google MAP or Project application (DDMS). Sometimes in difficult terrain the Maps is not based on actual distance and route. In such case is there any provision for additional Km approval?	In case there is a dispute on the distance provided by Google Map or 3PL application, the route proposed by 3PL service provider will be duly checked by MMDSL representative and approval will be provided in writing on rectified route before the FTL starts the distribution.
3	Refer Section VI – TOR 6.11, point no 4:- The loading and unloading will be borne by transporter as per Door-TO-Door Delivery which is ok up-to ground floor delivery. Is There any provision for multi floor pickup and deliveries like 1st floor and above.	Most of the warehouses of MMDSL are on the ground floor except 2 warehouses which have additional 1st floor. That said, loading and unloading will be the responsibility of the 3PL service provider.
4	Refer Section VI – TOR 6.11, point no 11 :- Service provider will be liable to pay for any damage or lost shipments in transit. That means the transit insurance will be service provider's liability. To get more clarity on the damage/lost amount, "Which amount will be considered. As per insurance company norms, service provider must declare the amount before initiating transportation. Is the document/Invoice given before initiating transportation is having the amount written on it."	A one-time comprehensive insurance can be taken for the entire expected consignment for the contract period. MMDSL will share the estimated value of shipment to be distributed yearwise.

The box size and weight will vary from shipment to shipment and the weight of the shipment will be confirmed by the consignor at the time of pickup.
7	In Financial Proposal page no 52, Reefer vehicle capacity only written. But the requirement for 2 slabs (2 – 8 Degree) and (- 20 Degree). So the rates for both slabs will be different.	The Appendix G: Financial Proposal has been revised. Kindly, ignore the previous Appendix G and quote price in the revised Appendix G in this corrigendum.
